NOTIFICATION FOR ENTRANCE EXAMINATION	<p>A letter will be posted out to notify all applicants of the date of the entrance examination. Parents will be told what their child needs to bring to the examination and the location of the examination room or hall.</p>	<p>For all students: Letters sent out by AICS Office by Friday 4th August 2017.</p> <p>For interstate and overseas students*: Letters sent out by AICS Office by Friday 22nd September 2017.</p>

EXAM	<p>Parents bring applicants to the AICS Office at 8:30am on the day of the examination. It will take approximately 2 hours to complete the exam and during this time the applicant will be fully supervised by multiple staff.</p> <p>Following the examination, staff will assess suitability for entry into the applied Year level, considering exam result as well as past academic performance.</p> <p>While tests assess expected performance, preparation is helpful. The tests cover Australian Curriculum Mathematics Content and assess Age-Appropriate Reading Comprehension.</p> <p>Students from overseas may find the test difficult and are encouraged to study and seek English language tuition beforehand.</p> <p>Support is are not provided during examinations.</p>	<p>2018 Examination Dates Applicants</p> <p>For all students: Friday 18 August 2017</p> <p>For interstate and overseas students*: Friday 6th October 2017</p>
