



2025 Kindergarten Enrolment

Parents wishing to enrol their child at AICS in Kindergarten in 2025 need to apply NOW.

Kindergarten application due date is **Thursday 1st August 2024**. Any application received after 1st August will not be processed for 2025 enrolment.

Enrolment Application must be submitted BEFORE Thursday 1st August 2024 by 4:00pm

Application

- Complete the online Enrolment Application form via the school website.
- Pay an application fee of \$50 (fee is non-refundable)
- Provide copies of documents requested in the application and any other information (Specialist reports such as Occupational Therapist, Speech Pathologists, Specialist Academic Assessment Report)
- Preschool Development Report from their preschool or early learning centre must be submitted (a minimum of 6 months attendance in a preschool is required)
- Application is processed in the order they are received.

Parent/ Child Interview

- Students who have applied to enrol are required to attend the Interview and orientation sessions. Interview will be conducted with the parents first and then the students will take part in the school readiness assessment. (writing names, correct pencil grip, number and counting skills 0 - 10, shape, colours, letter recognition)
Session 1: Interview Week 5 – Monday 19th August 2024-9:00am-3:00pm

Orientation Sessions

- Students who have passed the school readiness program will be invited to attend the orientation session, each child will be given a basic skills assessment to assess suitability for entry into kindergarten (which includes social skills, ability to use toilet independently, opening lunch box, eating independently and playing on the playground)
- Parents are encouraged to prepare students for their sessions by building their fine motor skills.

Session 2: Week 7- Monday 2nd September – Friday 6th September 2024- 8:30am 11.00am
Session 3: Week 8- Monday 9th September –Friday 13th September 2024- 8:30am-11.00am
Session 4: Week 9- Monday 16th September –Friday 27th September 2024- 8:30am-11.00am

Offer Letter & Payment

- Parents will be sent an offer letter based on the interview and orientation assessment
- Some students will be placed on waiting list due to limited places available.
- To secure the kindergarten places, parents of selected student must pay the **offer fees of \$100 before the due date stated in the offer letter.**

Parent Information Session

- Families of accepted students will be invited to Parent Information Session.
- This session will include; welcome pack, tour of the college, displays of Kindergarten work, a questions & answers and networking opportunity.
- Secure the kindergarten places, parents of selected student must pay the **offer fees of \$100 before the due date stated in the offer letter.**



2025 Year One to Year Six Enrolment

Parents wishing to enrol their child/children at AICS need to apply now for 2025.

All applications must be submitted by **Thursday 1st August 2024**. There will be limited number of places available in Years 1 to 6.

1. Enrolment Application must be completed BEFORE 1st August 2024 by parents

- Complete the Enrolment Application form.
- Pay an application fee of \$50 (This fee is non- refundable)
- Provide copies of all documents and any other information (Specialist reports such as Occupational Therapist, Speech Pathologists, Specialist Academic Assessment Report etc.
- Application will be processed in the order they are received.

2. Entrance Exam

- Applicants will complete an online exam using iPads/Laptops.
- It is recommended that parents prepare their children for the exam. Children who enter AICS should be able to read and comprehend at or above their grade level in English as well as have a high level of Mathematics proficiency.
- Date for 2025 enrolment tests will be informed to all applicants individually.

3. Verification of Documents

- Where necessary, office staff may schedule an interview with the Head of Primary School within 3 weeks of the exam.
- The 30-minute interview may be held to verify documentation e.g., school reports, Specialist reports such as Occupational Therapist, Speech Pathologists, Specialist Academic Assessment Report.
- Previous school's report card and NAPLAN results
- English as a second language (ESL) or special needs students' documents will be verified with specialist documents and discussion will be done regarding the requirements and facilities to cater the needs of the students.

4. Exam Outcomes

- Students will be selected based on the Entrance Exam result and parents will be sent an offer letter.
- Some students will be placed on waiting list due to limited places available.
To secure places in Year One to Six, parents must pay the fees of \$100 before the due date stated in the offer letter.
